SCRIPTURE READING: 1 Corinthians 2: 1-16 (Pew Bible p. 603) **PERSONAL REFLECTIONS**

Matthew 5: 43-45 – "You're familiar with the old written law, 'Love your friend,' and its unwritten companion, 'Hate your enemy.' I'm challenging that. I'm telling you to love your enemies. Let them bring out the best in you, not the worst. When someone gives you a hard time, respond with the energies of prayer, for then you are working out of your true selves, your God-created selves. This is what God does. He gives His best – the sun to warm and the rain to nourish – to everyone, regardless: the good and bad, the nice and nasty." (MSG)

- Luke 18: 23b "...became terribly sad. He was holding on tight to a lot of things and not about to let them go." (MSG)
- **1 Corinthians 1: 18** "... the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God." (NKJV)
- 1 Corinthians 14: 1a "Pursue love...."
- 1 Corinthians 12: 13, 20, & 27 "The old labels we once used to identify ourselves labels like Jew or Greek, slave or free are no longer useful. We need something larger, more comprehensive....
