October 7th we will have our quarterly benevolent fund offering and celebrating communion with our brothers and sisters around the world for World Communion Sunday.

The board is calling for a **Congregational Meeting** on **Sunday, October 7th after service** to consider the following recommendation. "The church board recommends that Hutterthal Mennonite Church retain the services of Ted Lewis and a co-facilitator to help bring healing and restore fellowship to our congregation." Further details will be provided in the coming days. We ask that you discuss this matter with board members to ask questions and express your views.

At the September 12 Congregational Meeting, the members present passed the following motion by a vote of 27 to 1. "The church board moves to authorize the trustees to sell the parsonage located at 809 S. Walnut with the church chairman acting as signatory for legal documents." Thank you to all who have shared their ideas and concerns in this matter.

Community and Beyond

We just received word from Meat Canning Coordinator John Hillegas (MCC Akron) that meat canning in Freeman has been cancelled for the 2018 season because of a lack of personnel. They had three "canner guys" but now one of them from Paraguay was denied a visa renewal. He was the gentleman to serve as truck driver. This limits greatly the number of stops the canner can make and MCC will can only in those communities where the canners stay for multiple days.
