CHILDREN'S TIME: "Remember the Pencil"

SCRIPTURE READING: Matthew 26: 26-30 (Pew Bible p. 525)

Personal Observations/Thoughts

Exodus 13: 8b-10 – "We are having this feast because of what the Lord did for [us] when [we] came out of [bondage]. This feast will help [us] remember, like a mark on [our] hand or a reminder on [our] forehead. This feast will remind [us] to speak the Lord's teachings, because the Lord used His great power to bring [us] out of [bondage]. So [we] celebrate this feast every year at the right time." (NCV)

Mark 1: 15b – "The time is fulfilled, and the Kingdom of God is at hand. Repent and believe in the gospel." (NKJV)

Matthew 26: 19 – "So the disciples did as Jesus had directed them; and they prepared the Passover." (NKJV)

Exodus 6: 6b – "I am the Lord; I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians...." (NKJV)

Matthew 26: 21b-23 – "Assuredly, I say to you, one of you will betray Me? And [the disciples] were exceedingly sorrowful, and each of them began to say to Him, 'Lord, is it I?' [And] He answered and said to them, 'He who dipped his hands with Me in the dish will betray Me.'" (NKJV)

Exodus 6: 6c – "I will rescue you from ... bondage...." (NKJV)

Exodus 6: 6d – "I will free you with My great power...." (NCV)

Exodus 6: 7 – "I will make you My own people, and I will be your God. You will know that I am the Lord your God, the One who saves you..." (NCV)
