- 1. Retreat:** Join us on Saturday evening, October 12 at 7:00pm for a prayer retreat focusing on our Harvest Mission Fest celebration. All are welcome!
- 2. Offering:** The ONLY opportunity to give to the special HMF offering will be during the morning service on October 13! No offering will be taken at the evening service. Please also note that following expenses the offering will be designated as follows: 80% Mennonite Mission Network; 20% CPMC.
- 3. Sunday Evening Meal:** We are asking that members and Friends of HMC bring 1 large salad and 1 pan of bars to share. Everything else will be provided!
- 4. Seating:** Please bring your own lawn chair and/or blanket.
- 5. Sunday School:** The Junior High through Adult Sunday School classes will meet with our speaker, Mark Van Steenwyk, in the sanctuary following our coffee fellowship.
- 6. HELPERS NEEDED:** For this event to be a success, we are in need volunteers to assist with the following –
 - a. Set-up:** This includes getting the serving tables arranged, making sure there are trash cans conveniently located for our attendees /guests, and general prep.
 - b. Clean-Up:** Wiping down all the tables, walking the park and picking up any trash, clearing the area and returning the park to “better than we found it.”
