# "A Relevant Church" September 28, 2014

**Scripture Reading:** Philippians 2: 1-11 (Pew Bible p. 620)

## **Defining Relevance**

**1 Corinthians 9: 20-23** - "To the Jews I became like a Jew, to win the Jews. To those under the law I became like one under the law (though I myself am not under the law), so as to win those under the law. To those not having the law I became like one not having the law (though I am not free from God's law but am under Christ's law), so as to win those not having the law. To the weak I became weak, to win the weak. I have become all things to all people so that by all possible means I might save some. I do all this for the sake of the gospel, that I may share in its blessings." (NIV)

John 18: 38b - "What is truth?" (NKJV)

Matthew 4: 17 - "Repent, for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand!" (NKJV)

1) we must \_\_\_\_\_\_! Ephesians 4: 15-16 - "... may grow up into Him who is the head—Christ from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love." (NKJV)

**Revelation 3: 16b-19** - "You're stale. You're stagnant. You make Me want to vomit. You brag, 'I'm rich, I've got it made, I need nothing from anyone,' oblivious that in fact you're a pitiful, blind beggar, threadbare and homeless. Here's what I want you to do: Buy your gold from Me, clothes designed in Heaven. You've gone around half-naked long enough. And buy medicine for your eyes from Me so you can see, *really* see. The people I love, I

call to account—prod and correct and guide so that they'll live at their best. Up on your feet, then! About face! Run after God!" (MSG)
