- ◇ 4 spiral or perforated-pages notebooks
(8.5 in x 10.5 in and 70 sheets)
- ◇ 8 new unsharpened pencils
- ◇ 1 ruler (flat, good quality; must indicate 30 cm;
inch markings optional)
- ◇ 12 colored pencils (in packaging)
- ◇ 1 large eraser
- ◇ 2 new black or blue ballpoint pens
- ◇ 1 small **all metal** pencil sharpener, one or two holes
