The sales event will follow the state recommended guidelines for safety from COVID 19.

The retail sales counter for smoked and unsmoked fresh sausage will be open March 20, 21, 27, and 28 from 1 -6 PM at the maintenance building on the Freeman Academy campus. Remaining sausage will be frozen and available for sale at the postponed Schmeckfest event. Due to difficult circumstances sausage supplies are reduced 40 percent from last year. From the Pastor's Heart: March 20, 2020

Dear Hutterthal Church family-- though the days seem dark do not be discouraged.

The world is anxious. People are deeply stressing and fearful of COVID-19. Even so, we have overcome the world in Christ. We can walk in His peace and be anxious for nothing. Philippians 4:4-7 reads, "Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! <sup>5</sup>Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. <sup>6</sup>Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. <sup>7</sup>And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

The Apostle Paul, in this text, urges us, earnestly, to bring our worries to God in prayer. List them one-by-one and lay them out before Him. I Peter 5:7 tell us "to be casting all our care on Him who cares for us," knowing, that He will meet our deepest apprehensions with His peace. Present your concerns, "request," to Him with a grateful, thankful heart. And the "peace of God will...." Have you ever experienced the peace of God? There is nothing to be anxious about. There is only confidence that He will hold you in His hand and attend to your every need. He will keep your mind and your heart calm in Christ Jesus. And you will not be disturbed by the worries of this world. Let God have whatever concern that wants of grip your life with fear and agitation. Give it to Him. Receive His peace. Amen
