Health Update & Prayers for Retired Conference Minister, Tim **Detweiler:** Over the last year, Tim Detweiler has been receiving a target therapy for the resurgence of his lung cancer. October tests showed that despite the treatment the cancer continues to grow advanced to a new stage. At the beginning of December, and has Tim was also hospitalized due to difficulty breathing. Among other causes, the target therapy medicine has been damaging his heart and a tumor is pressing on a key artery. With these discouraging developments, Tim has discontinued his daily target treatment, received five days of intensive radiation, and will begin a course of chemotherapy and/or immunotherapy infusions every three weeks for the foreseeable future.
