Today is **Anabaptist World Fellowship Sunday**. On January 21, 1525, the first Anabaptist baptisms took place in Zurich, Switzerland among a small group of reformers. The early Anabaptists understood this act of adult baptism to symbolize the presence of the Holy Spirit in the gift of God's grace, a commitment to a life of daily discipleship, and membership in a new community of God's people. Today, Anabaptists globally give thanks for our common roots, celebrate our worldwide fellowship, and look to God's guidance for the future.
