The Voices of Conscience exhibit at Heritage Hall Museum & Archives (HHM&A) that was interrupted by Covid-19 in 2020 has returned. It is open to museum visitors through Sunday, April 24. This traveling exhibit created by the Kauffman Museum in North Newton, Kan., remembers the witness of peace-minded people against the First World War 1914-1918. It premiered at the National World War I Museum in Kansas City at a symposium in October 2017 and then began a tour across North America. After the interruption created by the pandemic, the tour has resumed: it was installed at the historic Bethel Mennonite Church at HHM&A. Admission to the exhibit is included with the regular admission fee of \$8 for adults, \$6 for seniors and \$ for students (grades 1-12). A program coinciding with the exhibit will be held at Pioneer Hall on March 25 & 26 starting at 7:30 each evening. It will focus on one of the stories in the display, the Hutterites from this community including experience of Michael Hofer, who died from mistreatbrothers Joseph and ment while imprisoned by the United States military system.
