Congregational Ministries Project for November: CASH for Mennonite Disaster Service (MDS): MDS is a volunteer network of Anabaptist churches that responds in Christian love to those affected by disasters in Canada and the United States. While the main focus is on cleaning up, repairing, and rebuilding homes, this service touches lives and nurtures hope, faith, and wholeness.

Mennonite Central Committee Material Resources Center in North Newton is critically low on inventory: An MCC kit cannot be shipped until every single item for the kit is assembled, but some supplies are so low that kits cannot be processed for shipping. You can help by helping to fill the following needs:

- New infant onesies and sleepers (3-12 month sizes)
- Shampoo (20 oz or more)
- Thin sanitary pads (28 count minimum)
- Dark colored bath and hand towels.
