

National Day of Prayer May 4, 2023

James 5:16b "The effective, fervent prayer of the righteous avails much."

The National Day of Prayer is an annual day of observance held on the first Thursday of May, designated by the United States Congress, when people are asked "to turn to God in prayer and meditation."

Though days of prayer were decreed as far back as the 1700's, The National Day of Prayer that we know today was founded in 1952, an effort between the United States Congress and signed into law by President Harry S. Truman. It stands as a day that continues to encourage the decision-making of the country's founding fathers, which used Biblical morals for difficult situations.

The National Day of Prayer is celebrated by Americans of many religions and faiths.

Traditionally, the President of the United States issues an official National Day of Prayer proclamation each year and observances are held around the country on courthouse steps as well as houses of worship.
