The deacons are excited to announce that our guest speaker will be **Kerry Hilton**. Since 1997 Kerry has worked remotely for Habitat for Humanity International, based in Americus, Georgia. Habitat for Humanity is a nonprofit organization that helps families build and improve places to call home. Habitat believes affordable housing plays a critical role in strong and stable communities.

Currently, Kerry is the Director of Global Knowledge Management at Habitat, supervising a remote team with staff based from Nairobi, Kenya to Boise, Idaho. The team of eight includes members with expertise in Library Science, Automation, Data Analysis, Adult Learning, User Experience, Governance/Compliance, Information Technology, Technical Writing and Copy Editing. During her first 20 years of employment with Habitat, Kerry traveled around the U.S. training Habitat boards of directors on a wide range. Kerry splits her time between a small barnyard near Bridgewater, where she chases goats out of the gardens and Emery, where her husband Wes is the High School science teacher, and their youngest daughter Lily is a freshman. Wes and Kerry met in 1990 as Peace Corps Volunteers in Africa, serving as Fisheries Extension Agents to help local farmers increase the yield of tilapia in their aquaculture ponds. A more detailed invitation will be placed in your mailboxes at a later date.

On October 29 we will have a special congregational meeting following the worship service.

The Education committee has brought forth the following explanation along with the proposed constitutional and by-law changes that would need to be made. The church board has approved these changes and is bringing them forward to the congregation for approval.

This past year the Education Committee has been operating with one less person than in the past. Previously we have had an adult supt., assistant adult supt., children's supt., assistant children's supt., sec-treasurer and elected member. Because we don't have as many people to fill all the roles in church, we propose to restructure the Education Committee as to how we were functioning this past year. Instead of electing people for the supt. position, it would be a team of three that would be elected. The Sec.-Treas. and the elected member at large would be appointed by the Education Committee. The person elected to the 3-person team would be elected for a 3-year term and would serve as chair the final year of their term. The Committee members would determine the responsibilities of each person on the committee according to their gifts.

Here are the proposed constitution and by-law changes being voted on. Red lettering is old wording being replaced by wording in bold.

CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE VI: OFFICERS AND DUTIES

Section 1: List of Officers

A. The officers of the church shall be: Church Chair, 3
*Deacons, Secretary, Treasurer, Adult Sunday School
Superintendent Education Committee Chair, 3
Trustees and such other officers as the congregation deems necessary.

Section 3: The Church Board

A. The church board shall consist of the Church Chair, Deacons, Secretary, Treasurer, Sunday School Superintendent Education Committee Chair, Trustees, and Advisor of the Youth Group

F. Duties of Sunday School Officers

1. The Sunday School Superintendent Education Committee Chair and Assistant shall direct and oversee the work of the Sunday School and give reports thereof to the congregation

BY-LAWS

THE EDUCATION COMMITTEE

The Education Committee shall consist of the Adult Sunday School Superintendent, Assistant Adult Sunday School Superintendent, Children's Sunday School Superintendent, Assistant Children's Sunday School Superintendent, Secretary-Treasurer, 1 elected member, three elected members, two members to be appointed by the Education Committee (sec-treas. & member at large) and the Pastor.
