Here are the proposed constitution and by-law changes being voted on at annual meeting. Bold, red lettering notes the suggested additions.

ARTICLE VI: OFFICERS AND DUTIES

Section 1: List of Officers

A. The officers of the church shall be: Church Chair, 3 *Deacons, Secretary, Treasurer, Christian Education Committee Chair, 3 Trustees and such other officers as the congregation deems necessary.

Section 3: The Church Board

A. The church board shall consist of the Church Chair, Deacons, Secretary, Treasurer, Christian Education Committee Chair, Trustees, and Advisor of the Youth Group.

- F. Duties of Sunday School Officers
 - 1. The Christian Education Committee Chair shall direct and oversee the work of the Sunday School and give reports thereof to the congregation.

The Christian Education Committee shall consist of three elected members, two members to be appointed by the Christian Education Committee (sec-tres. & member at large) and the Pastor.
