Moment of Quiet Reflection

Leader: Now hear these words of assurance: God tells us that we are created in God's image. God created us for relationship with God and each other. In this, we know that God will never break our relationship. God's steadfast love endures forever. The Deacons and Pastor Randall invite you to our **annual Maundy Thursday service** on April 17 at 7 PM in the fellowship hall. We will be sharing in music, scripture, <u>foot</u> <u>washing</u>, and communion during our time together. Foot washing is new to our congregation, but it is a traditional practice, rooted in Anabaptist Mennonite communities since the radical reformation. Pastor Randall and the deacons encourage you to participate in this practice for the first time, but participation is still optional for all who attend. If you have any questions or concerns about participating in foot washing on Maundy Thursday, please reach out to Pastor Randall or a deacon (Lyndon, Amy, Suzanne).
